Spend time on Times Tables Rockstars or Numbots to improve your quick-fire maths skills!

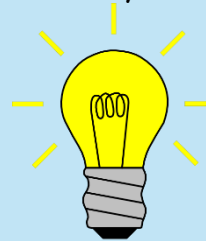
