

ENGLISH

This half term, we are going to be writing a narrative based on the book 'Julian is a Mermaid'. Children will explore the story and work on their descriptive writing skills before inventing their own character and narrative structure adapted from the original book.

COMPUTING

In computing, we are going to be learning all about the internet and online network systems. We will discuss what is meant by the term 'digital' and how digital devices are connected to the World Wide Web.

SCIENCE

In science this term, we will be continuing to look at forces. This half term, we will primarily focus on friction. We are going to be undertaking experiments to discover how forces affect the movement of objects and investigating with different surfaces to see how it changes friction.

PE

This half term, we will be doing hockey in PE. The children will be learning how to move appropriately and play together as a team, as well as working in pairs and small groups to practice their hockey techniques.

PSHE

In PSHE this half term, we will be exploring how we can cope with sensitive situations and unpicking further how it is okay for some people to feel differently to others, even in the same situations.

SPELLING and READING

We will be reading The Enchanted Wood by Enid Blyton as a whole class throughout the term.

Please read at home with your child at least 3 times per week and record this in their reading record.

Pupils take part in 3 spelling lessons a week and we will be practising spelling in discreet lessons at school. Within this time, children will become familiarised with high frequency words and common exception words.

HOMEWORK

At the beginning of each new half term, a homework menu of additional tasks is sent home with an end of term deadline.

MATHS

This half term, we are going to be revising our addition and subtraction skills, building on previous knowledge by using number lines with tricky sums. We will then move on to looking at reading the time, identifying each hour, half an hour and other increments on both digital and analogue clocks.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

In DT, we are working towards creating our own pop-up easter cards. We will look at how professionals create and market products, come up with our own innovative designs and evaluate the choices we make. In the last week of half term, we will then have a day dedicated to creating our cards in time for the Easter Holidays!

LANGUAGES

This half term, our German lessons will be focused on learning new vocabulary to describe how we are feeling.

GEOGRAPHY

We are focussing on our comparison skills this half term In Geography, comparing the UK and Australia! Throughout the weeks, we will investigate the key features (both human and physical) in each country and see how they are similar or different to one another.

RE

This term, RE will focus on the question 'Who is important to you?'. The children will be encouraged to reflect upon important figures across religions and relate this to their own ideas of who is important.
