READING & TTRS

Reading with your child is proven to improve their outcomes. Please try and read with your child weekly and write in their reading record.

Three minutes a day using Times Tables Rock Star can have a huge impact on your child's mathematics. Please encourage frequent use of this program.

MATHS In maths this half term we will be focused on revising concepts of 2D and 3D shape, as well as areas of position and direction including coordinates and translations. We will continue to embed daily arithmetic skills and have WOW Maths 3 times a week.

ART & DESIGN This term, our unit focuses on the abstract artwork of Kandinsky and a group of artists known as The Blue Rider. We will appraise their work, create work in their style and use skills to create our own expressionist work.

HISTORY This term we are studying the Kingdom of Benin. We will construct a timeline of key events and make comparison to British history, we will learn about important leaders and consider the 'greatest', identify how the kingdom grew to its Golden Age and how the British Empire led to its demise and consider if historical artefacts should be returned.

RE In RE this term, the children will be investigating different places of worship and identifying similarities and differences.
