How can we stay safe when using electrical appliances?

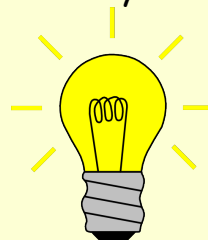


We have learnt the numbers in German.

Can you create a game, teach a family member, make a poster?

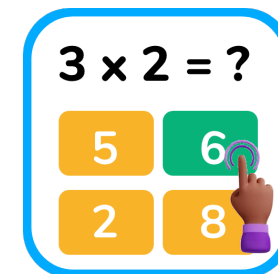


An idea of your own...
